

PITCHER PARK SCOREBOARD OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Collect secure cupboard keys & turn on the Scoreboard Fuse

Enter the MAIN PAVILION building to:

- (1) Collect the key for the laptop secure cupboard.
Open the switchboard cupboard & you will see a set of keys on a hook at the top left side.
- (2) Turn **ON** the scoreboard power supply by turning the **Scoreboard 34** fuse to the **ON** position.

Refer to Figures 1 & 2 below.

Step 2: Open the Timekeeper/Scorers Room and the Scoreboard Roller Door

Walk over to the Timekeeper/Scorers room and when inside manually open the roller shutter screen. You will see the scoreboard on the opposite side of the ground.

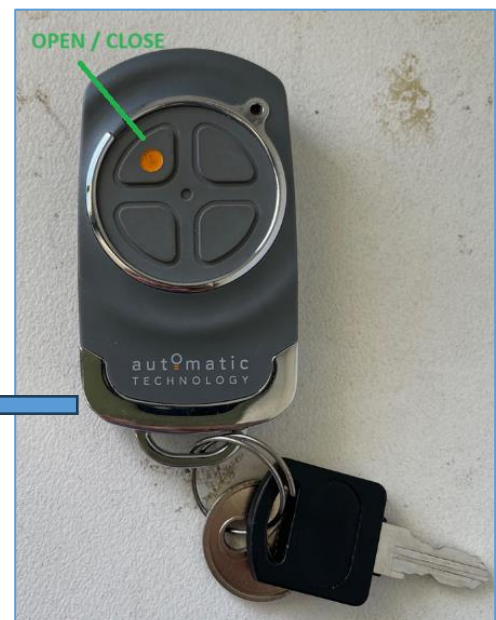


Figure 3: Secure cupboard and scoreboard roller-door remote control

- Unlock the Secure Cupboard where the Remote-Control Unit for the automatic scoreboard roller door is located. Refer to Figure 3. below.
- Point the remote-control unit at the scoreboard to open the automatic roller door by pressing on the top left **orange dot** button.
- Place the remote-control unit back inside the secure cupboard.

Note: You may need to walk towards the scoreboard with the remote-control unit in-hand to activate the automatic scoreboard roller door.

Step 3: Setting up the scoreboard display and scoring

- A laptop computer, iPad and 4G Hotspot Wi-Fi unit are located on the desk.
 - The laptop and 4G Hotspot Wi-Fi are to remain in the scoring room at all times.
 - The iPad can be moved externally by NACC for cricket scoring. Note: It must stay in range to the Wi-Fi.

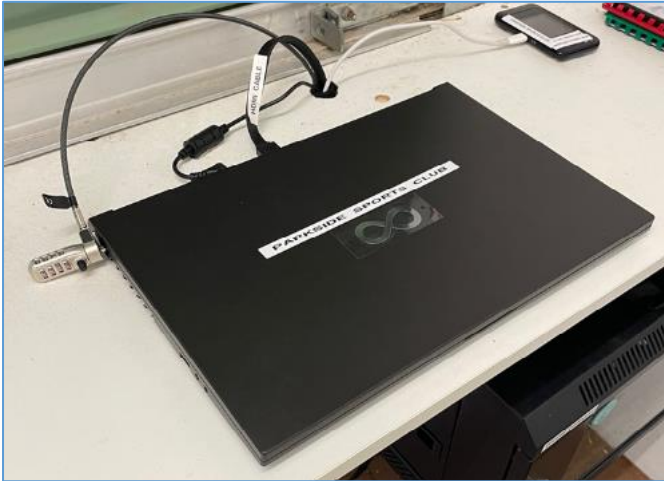


Telstra 4G Hotspot Wi-Fi Unit

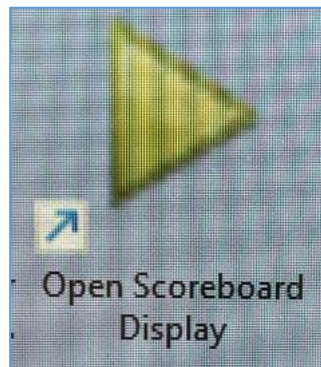


- Turn on the Wi-Fi unit
 - Wi-Fi network: **TPW4G_AY6U6X**
 - Password: **8747238365**
- Ensure that there is sufficient power in the unit. Ideally leave it plugged into power.

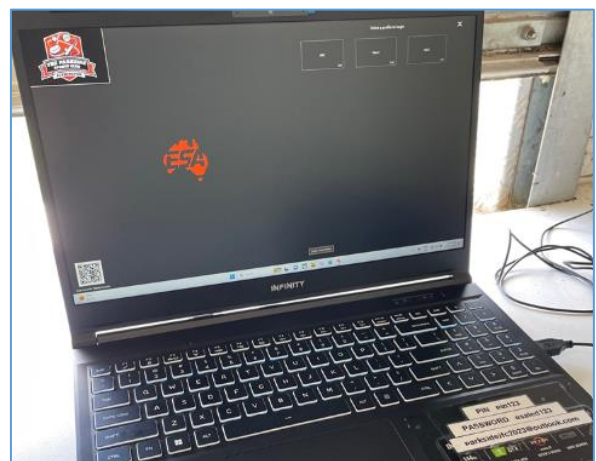
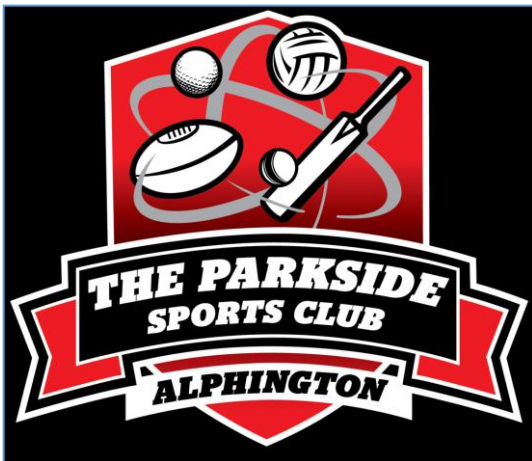
Laptop Computer



- Turn the laptop computer **ON** and enter password **pin123**
- Ensure that the laptop is connected to Wi-Fi Hotspot connection to **TPW4G_AY6U6X**
- Ensure that the HDMI Cable, Power-cord and Mouse are all connected.
- Select the icon titled **“Open Scoreboard Display”**



- The Parkside Sports Club Logo will appear on the 2m x 3m scoreboard screen.
- Select **NACC, PJFC or PAFC** for your particular sport/club.



Apple iPad to be used for scoring / Play HQ application

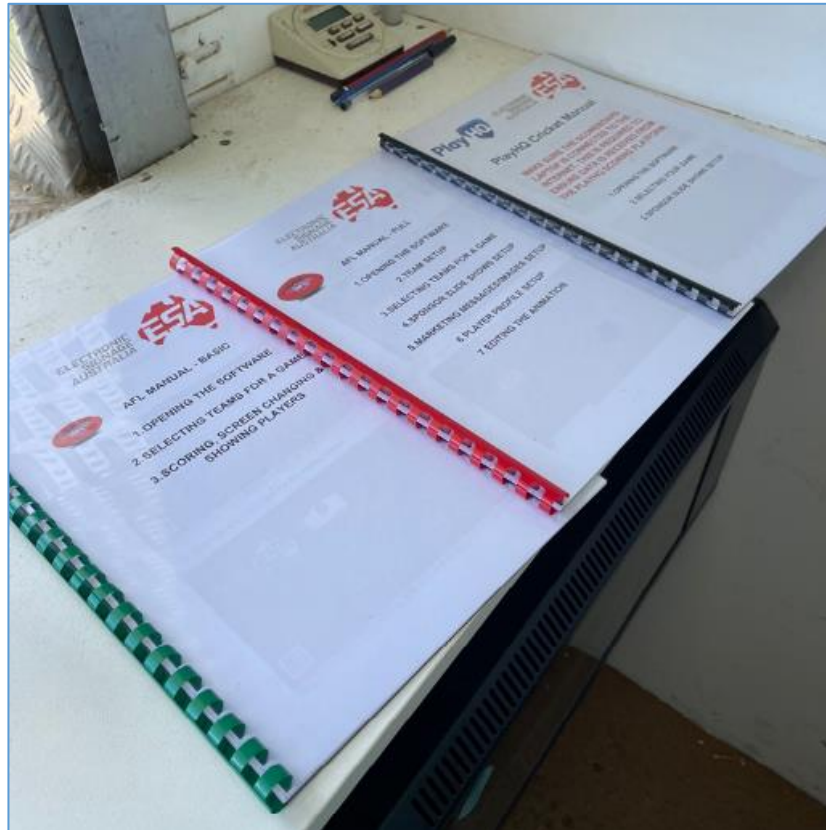


- Turn **ON** the iPad
- Password **200600**
- Ensure that the iPad is connected to Wi-Fi Hotspot connection to **TPW4G_AY6U6X**
- The iPad is to be used for scoring using Play HQ.
- Select **NACC, PJFC or PAFC** for your particular sport/club

Step 4: Scoring for your game

Refer to the printed ESA instruction books for **PJFC, NACC and PAFC**.

There are printed copies of these instructions in the time-keepers room, and they are also saved on the laptop desktop files.



Shutdown and Lock-up

At the conclusion of your game, you can either leave the iPad and laptop ON for the next team to use or if you are the last team to play at Pitcher Park for the day please complete the following:

- Close the software applications on both the iPad and laptop computer.
- Shutdown the iPad and laptop.
- Ensure the iPad, Laptop Computer and 4G Hotspot Wi-Fi unit are all on the desk and on charge. See the below images.
- Use the remote-control unit to close the Scoreboard Roller Door by pushing the **orange** button on the remote-control unit.
- Ensure the remote-control unit is placed back in the secure cupboard.
- Lock the secure cupboard.
- Shut and secure the manual roller screen shutter.
- Exit the scoring/timekeepers room ensuring it is clean and rubbish free. Turn off all lights and lock the door behind you.

Walk to the Main Pavilion to:

- Return the secure cupboard key back to the hook inside the switchboard cupboard.
- Turn OFF the Scoreboard #34 fuse.
